As the capitalist economy veers toward a new depression, keeping itself afloat only by inflationary declines in real wages for all workers, "productivity drives" (speed-up) in all plants, and "cost-cutting programs" at all levels of government virtually wiping out public services and education, this year's PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION offers a "choice" between two pro-wage freeze, anti-working class candidates, the Phase II buddies, Nixon and McGovern.

Clearly, a serious alternative is needed - especially in the South, where the "third choice" is George Wallace or his like, a man with the worst anti-labor record imaginable.

Bob Kaufman is now running for Congress in Baltimore, Maryland, with a program which addresses all the major issues facing working people around the country - increased income, job security, and employment in the construction of much needed housing, schools, and greatly expanded public services - to be financed at capitalist expense, not through additional levies on already over-burdened, tax-paying wage-earners. Plus - the right of all working class layers to ORGANIZE for these goals.

Does Kaufman, who is running on behalf of the National Caucus of Labor Committees and the Baltimore Strike Support Organizing Committee, actually expect to win against the candidates of the established capitalist parties? No. But his aim is not that. The aim of his campaign is to begin the process of building a working class party, uniting all sections of working people, employed and unemployed, black and white, trade unionist and welfare victims, around a common program, in clear opposition to both capitalist parties.

Not just an electoral party, but a fighting pro-working class organization ready to intervene in support of the day-to-day struggles of all sections of the working class and unite them around common programs in common struggles against the common enemy.

The Kaufman campaign is therefore the clear alternative for working people.
