The plans of the capitalists are clear: inflation, rationing, budget cuts, speed-up, layoffs, forced work for slave wages. In a depression, only fascism will save the capitalists. To carry out these schemes they must set the working class to fighting amongst ourselves over the crumbs. Already unemployed workers on welfare are being starved and driven into taking jobs away from other workers. In the same way, Southern workers are used as the cheap and docile labor to break unions nationwide.

Will you try to fight alone? Will you cling to a dream of how you by yourself will "make it"? Will you wait until you have been driven into the ground and only then burst out in wild, unplanned anger, in suicidal protest? Or will you just quietly fall to your knees?

There is an alternative to suicide -- we can win. We can take on the government and demand jobs, food, housing, education -- decent lives for all. We can establish a working class socialist government in this country by the end of the 1970's. The united class organization of leaders is now being built and is already leading fights in defense of the working class. The National Caucus of Labor Committees (NCLC) and the National Unemployed and Welfare Rights Organization (NU-WRO) are organizing throughout the country against government recycling/slave-labor schemes and against the CIA counter-insurgency/community-control apparatus.

Where will you be? Buried beneath the collapse of capitalism OR fighting to unite the working class into a new society? There is no place to hide; no way to "move on" as Southern workers have always done when times got bad.
