

The Real Criminals - the CIA



The Secret Service is trying to put this man - and his ideas - in jail. He is Michael McGill, a member of the national steering committee of the Revolutionary Youth Movement (RYM) and an active organizer for RYM in Charlotte.

On Sept. 5 in Newark, N.J., McGill participated in a highly successful exposure of domestic CIA attacks directed against black and white working people...the next week he was subpoenaed before a federal grand jury in Charlotte. And on Oct. 16, one week before the first national RYM convention, a warrant was issued for his arrest on 3 charges concerning the theft, 7 months earlier, of one government check. The warrant was based on a statement by a man widely known to be a police informer. Extraordinary bail of \$10,000 was set.

McGill's case is one of a growing collection of political frameups against RYM, the most notorious being the arrest of 2 New York RYM organizers who were charged with resisting when the police, without a warrant, broke in and ransacked the Lower East Side RYM office.

Michael McGill - a RYM-U.S. Labor Party candidate for the Board of Education - is stepping forward, organizing youth to defend the living standards of the entire working class. To a government determined to destroy those living standards, that is a crime. Contact RYM at Box 1606, Charlotte.
