This was our first analysis of S. 1400 in the 93rd Congress (see pages 302 to 309). This was a collective writing effort to provide an historical perspective to such repressive legislation.

PRELIMINARY ANALYSIS: This represents our analysis of S. 1 following its introduction on January 15, 1975. Other than the "WATERGATE CRIMES" section, which public pressure has caused to be amended, and some minor word changes, we consider this accurate. Note that each titled is also listed by page number; with a copy of S. 1 from your own Senators, you can draw your own judgments.
