

**Visiting: MOSCOW, CAIRO, NEW DELHI, AGRA, BANARES, CALCUTTA, BANGKOK,
HONG KONG, KYOTO, TOKYO, HONOLULU
plus special program in HIROSHIMA**

July 16 LEAVE NEW YORK on SANE's 'Round-the-World Tour via Air France Jet to PARIS.

July 17 ARRIVE PARIS in the morning. Tour of the city and special luncheon. Continue to CAIRO, arriving in evening.

July 18 CAIRO. Morning tour of the Egyptian Museum including treasures from the Tomb of Tutankhamon. Afternoon drive to the Pyramids, the Granite Temple and the Sphinx.

July 19 CAIRO. Morning tour visiting the Bazaar, the Citadel, Tombs of the Caliphs and Mosques. Afternoon free.

July 20 LEAVE CAIRO on morning flight to MOSCOW.

July 21 MOSCOW. Morning tour of city visiting Red Square, Moscow University. Afternoon tour of Metro stations.

July 22 MOSCOW. Morning tour of the Kremlin, Armoury Museum and Lenin's Tomb. Afternoon free.

July 23 MOSCOW. Morning visit to USSR Exhibition of Economic Achievements. Afternoon free.

July 24 MOSCOW. Morning free. Afternoon departure to INDIA on overnight flight.

July 25 ARRIVE NEW DELHI in the morning. Afternoon tour of Old Delhi including Red Fort, Pearl Mosque.

July 26 NEW DELHI. Morning tour of New Delhi including Government buildings, India Gate, Raj Ghat.

July 27 LEAVE NEW DELHI on morning flight to AGRA. Afternoon visit to Taj Mahal, Mogul Fort, Pearl Mosque.

July 28 Morning flight from AGRA to BANARES, the Holy City on the Ganges. Afternoon tour to SARNATH where Buddha delivered his first sermon.

July 29 BANARES. Morning boat ride along the Ganges where pilgrims bathe and pray. Afternoon flight to CALCUTTA.

July 30 CALCUTTA. Morning tour of city including Temple and Botanical Gardens. Afternoon free.

July 31 Morning flight from CALCUTTA to BANGKOK. Afternoon tour visiting Royal Palace and Emerald Buddha.

Aug. 1 BANGKOK. Morning tour of floating market in the canals outside Bangkok. Afternoon free.

Aug. 2 LEAVE BANGKOK in the morning and fly to HONG KONG.

Aug. 3 HONG KONG. Morning tour to Kowloon and the New Territories along the Chinese Border.

Aug. 4 HONG KONG. Morning tour of Hong Kong Island including Victoria Peak, Tiger Balm Gardens, Aberdeen fishing village. Afternoon flight to OSAKA for overnight stay.

Aug. 5 Fly from OSAKA to HIROSHIMA in early morning. Afternoon visit to Atomic Research Center.

Aug. 6 HIROSHIMA. 20th Anniversary of the bombing. Special observances.

Aug. 7 HIROSHIMA. Visit to the Dome of Peace with additional program to be planned.

Aug. 8 LEAVE HIROSHIMA on morning flight to KYOTO. Afternoon tour including Hall of 1,001 Buddhas, Heian Shrine and garden, Old Imperial Palace.

Aug. 9 KYOTO. Morning tour visiting Nijo Castle, Gold Pavilion, craftsmen's workshops. Afternoon free.

Aug. 10 Fly from KYOTO to TOKYO in the morning. Afternoon tour including Imperial Palace Plaza, Meiji Shrine Art Gallery.

Aug. 11 TOKYO. Full day free. Optional excursion to NIKKO. (\$15 per person.)

Aug. 12 LEAVE TOKYO in the morning on flight to HONOLULU. Cross International Date Line and gain one day.

Aug. 11 ARRIVE HONOLULU in the evening.

Aug. 12 HONOLULU. Full day free for swimming, relaxing.

Aug. 13 HONOLULU. Full day free.

Aug. 14 HONOLULU. Morning free. LEAVE HONOLULU in the afternoon on overnight flight via Los Angeles to NEW YORK.

AUG. 15 ARRIVE NEW YORK early morning.

TOUR FEATURES AND CONDITIONS

The price of \$1,525 per person includes:

AIR FARE: Economy and Tourist Class flights—jet wherever available—as indicated on itinerary. Rate based on 'round-the-world group fare from New York with minimum of 15 passengers. Rates from other cities in U.S. and Canada only slightly higher, and will be quoted upon application. (Approximately \$5 to \$25 additional, based on special fare structure.)

HOTELS: Accommodations in first class hotels with private bath, basis two to a room. Supplement of \$70 for a single room. Air-conditioned rooms everywhere except Moscow. If you wish to share a room, every effort will be made to accommodate you, but if not possible, the single supplement will be charged.

MEALS: Three meals daily in Moscow; Breakfast and either lunch or dinner daily elsewhere except Honolulu where no meals are included.

SIGHTSEEING: As indicated on itinerary including entrance fees and services of local guides. Air-conditioned buses will be used wherever that equipment is available.

TRANSFERS: Meetings, assistance through customs, transfers to and from hotels by private motorcoach including portage of two pieces of luggage per person. Note: Baggage allowance is 44 pounds and charges for excess baggage are very high.

GRATUITIES: Included at hotels, restaurants and airports.

THE TOUR DOES NOT INCLUDE:

Passport charges, visa fees (see note below), airport taxes, insurance, excess baggage charges, laundry, room service or any other expenses of a purely personal nature.

ELIGIBILITY

All members of National SANE as of January 15, 1965 are eligible to participate in this tour. Wives, husbands, dependent children and parents residing in member's household may accompany the member.

PAYMENTS

Deposit of \$200 per person upon application. Balance of \$1,325 due May 15, 1965. Refunds in full until May 15 (except for \$10 handling fee.) Full refund after May 15 *only if eligible replacement is available*. Maximum cancellation fee \$250 per person up to 2 weeks before departure. After that cable charges or other out-of-pocket expenses may be added.

VISAS

Visa applications and instructions will be sent to all registrants. There will be a handling charge of \$5 per person for the Soviet visa since this can not be obtained by individual members. Visas are also required for Egypt, India, Hong Kong and Japan. These may be obtained directly from local consulates or we will secure them for you at a charge of \$5 per visa.
