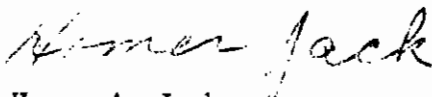
If you are not already a regular recipient of this monthly paper, you may wish to be. You will find an outline of SANE's policies in our brochure. All members receive SANE/USA.
