Directions

If arriving by bus or train:

Board a west bound "Lake-Dan Ryan" train at the Wabash-Madison stop of the Elevated. Get off at the Marion-Harlem station in Oak Park. Call 771-8300 Ext. 460-61-62 and we will arrange to pick you up, or you can take a taxi to the campus (approx. fare \$1.00 from Marion-Harlem station).

If arriving by plane.

Take airport limousine to the Palmer House from O'Hare and procede as above.

If arriving by car:

Take the Eisenhower Expressway west to Harlem Ave. (exit from left lane) and make a right turn. Drive 2 miles north on Harlem Ave. to Augusta Blvd. (stop light). Turn left two blocks to campus entrance.

If arriving by car from the west:

East-West Toll Road becomes Eisenhower Expressway. Continue east on Eisenhower to Harlem Ave and continue as above.

HOUSING

Arrangements are being made in advance for group "sleeping bag" housing in the immediate vicinity of Concordia so that we can pick you up Sunday morning and bring you to the Conference.
