NCRD learned today that Senator Mark Hatfield's amendment to end the induction authority will likely be called up during debate on the Military Procurement Authorization Bill Tuesday, August 1.

It is imperative that Key Senators receive telegrams, phone calls or letter to support the "end the draft" amendment. NCRD Washington staff is attempting contact with all original co-sponsors. THE REAL CHANCE FOR A LARGE YEA VOTE ON THE AMENDMENT IS NOW IN YOUR HANDS.

It is first of all important to encourage Hatfield, who feels somewhat alone this time, and to urge McGovern to come to Washington for a vote and to play an active role.

A second target group consists of liberals, mostly Democrats, who have some qualms about the vote, especially in an election year. Those starred voted for the Hatfield amendment last year for immediate end of the draft. Some of them, but especially the others, have been worried about a "leavening influence of draftees in Vietnam" and concerned that "wartime burdens be shared by all." This is no longer a valid point since Nixon has announced no more draftees will be sent to Vietnam. Those with a #1 voted for one year extension of the draft (rather than the 2 years sought by Nixon).
