Peace actions by GIs took place all over the country this fall. These actions confirmed that there are many things GIs can do to help bring peace that are perfectly legal and entirely within their rights. In San Francisco on October 12, more than 500 active-duty GIs led and organized a march against the war in Vietnam; 15,000 civilians joined in. On October 21-27 GIs in many areas spoke out at rallies, teach-ins, and demonstrations. This is just a beginning. Students and GIs are coming together to set the date for a major peace action by GIs and civilians in the spring. GIs stationed overseas, from Vietnam to West Germany and students around the world will take part in the spring action.
