This Thursday, Feb. 25, at 7:30 P.M. at the YWCA, 2027 Chestnut St., Philadelphia NPAC will hold its next work meeting to continue organizing the activities we projected at our Feb. 6 regional conference. Since the conference several working committees --- April 2, 3, 4; April 24; May 5 and May 16; Finance --- have begun the work necessary to make the spring actions successful locally, as the national NPAC staff has accelerated its organizational efforts by opening offices in San Francisco and Washington, and by placing a full page ad in the Feb. 14 Sunday N.Y. Times signed by more than fifty prominent individuals, including ten congressmen, that calls for support of the April 24 March on Washington.

Now that Laos and Cambodia have been invaded and the invasion of North Vietnam is imminent, it is more important than ever for you to bring your most creative, dynamic ideas to bear on the task of making the spring actions more powerful than any previous peace offensive.
