Chu Tai, Viet Nam

Will write a few lines while I hang all my stuff together. We are supposed to go to the bush tomorrow so it will be a while before I have a chance again.

For the last three days the company has been on standdown here in the rear. Everyone comes in for three days to rest up and get drunk. We are supposed to go out tomorrow to set up a new fire base pretty close to Laos. The company has been doing quite a bit of moving around lately which is a bitch in this heat. Hope to settle down pretty soon.

I have been here three weeks now, time goes a little faster here but not fast enough. Still waiting to get some mail from home. Should be due real quick.

There are a few guys in my company here that I took training with in Knox. All of us are grunts now, we may get reassigned later, but I kind of doubt it. The army is too fucked up to do that.

Well, I think I had better close now. I won't write much, there isn't much to say about this place that makes any sense. Will write when I can but don't expect it too often.
