HOUSTON, TEX (UPI)—The Apollo-7 spaceship entered the fifth day of its moon trip test run Tuesday with another live television show topping its schedule.

Monday's highlights: the astronauts corrected their first major problem, an electrical malfunction; conducted the first live space television show; conducted a nine second firing of its biggest rocket, dropping to a lower, safer orbit of 103 by 184 miles high; made successful contact with a moon landing craft radar set in New Mexico; mopped up spouts of troublesome moisture; and took additional medication to combat colds and "stuck ears."


Professional Rd. Layer of Australia
