We haven't been out lately because of convoys to Saigon. The Company went to Saigon as guards for the convey that went down. They were gone for 2 days. I stayed here but most everyone else went. I didn't do anything except set around.

I don't go out with the company much. I

am usually left back here
cause my platoon never goes
out with the Company.
Sure hope I get to
stay back most of the
time.

I've gotten most all
of the packages you've
sent I guess, today I
got the clothes. Did it
need the Army shirt
at all but will keep it
till I get home.

So you might move
to Hinton in February.

Guess it will seem strange

to you won't it. Is

Dorthea talking about moving

so that you could have

their house? That sure

would be nice if she would.
But I will buy the trailer
house when you finish
with it.

Well I hope from
your letter that they are
talking about peace. We
sure haven't heard anything
about it.

If you see anything
in the paper about USD
wrestling send it over.

Well guess I'd best close
& hit the hay.
