C I T A T I O N

While assigned as Senior Advisor, Vinh Binh Province, Lieutenant Colonel Edward P. Metzner energetically supported the Open-Arms program, thus obtaining a plenty of fruitful results in the year of 1970 for the province.

In the aspect of propaganda, LTC Metzner assisted effectively in providing ground and air transportation for Armed Propaganda Units to drop a great quantity of leaflets in each local area, and on a permanent basis, in areas where Armed Propaganda Open-Arms Cadre were unable to access.

In the military area, Lieutenant Colonel Edward P. Metzner worked fervently in close coordination with the Republic of Vietnam Armed Forces and the Local Open-Arms Agency thereby the results of the exploitation of information collected by Open-Arms returnees were completely favorable.

Noteworthy was on 19 December 1970, due to the US logistical support and close cooperation made between RVNAF units and Open-Arms returnees, an NVA Engineer workshop was discovered in Tra Vinh province with the results listed below:
