LTC FETZNER has immeasurably contributed his initiatives of staff, battle field and intelligence information for Kien Giang Sector. He also closely controlled the allied units who were effectively supporting for this territory. Particularly in the operation 62/AV/75 from 15 May to 10 June 1970, the friendly forces advanced across Cambodia to destroy NVA base camp. LTC FETZNER has always demonstrated his great mutual support for Kien Giang Sector in getting successful results, killing 30 North Communists, capturing 4 POW's, 1 machine gun and 14 individual weapons.
