Locating Retired Military

Most members of the military have to serve between 15 to 20 years of active duty to retire from the military. Reserve members can also retire after years of reserve service and receive retirement pay and benefits when they reach age 60. Each branch of the military (excluding Army) operates a Retired Locator. This locator will forward a letter to the retired military member. Following is the list for all branches except Army.
