DAILY INTERNAL INFORMATION SUMMARY NO. 01-17

FOUR ASPB'S OF RIVER DIVISION 111 SUPPORTED A ONE-BATALION CORDON AND SEARCH OPERATION TUESDAY IN AN QUOI HAMLET JUST EAST OF DONG TAM. FOUR COMPANIES OF 3/47 INFANTRY BATTALION AND UNITS OF THE VIETNAMESE NATIONAL POLICE SURROUNDED THE VILLAGE ON THREE SIDES, WHILE THE BOATS COMPLETED THE TRAP WITH WATERBORNE BLOCKS ON THE SONG MY THO.

SIXTY-EIGHT DETAINEES WERE TAKEN DURING THE OPERATION, WHICH RAN FROM 0400 TO 1100. ALTHOUGH THERE WAS NO CONTACT WITH ENEMY FORCES, TWELVE U.S. ARMY PERSONNEL WERE INJURED BY BOOBY TRAPS.

CHARLEY COMPANY OF 3/60 INFANTRY RECEIVED SMALL ARMS AND AUTOMATIC WEAPONS FIRE TUESDAY EVENING JUST AFTER BEACHING ON THE SOUTH BANK OF THE MY THO OPPOSITE THE MRB FOR A TRAINING EXERCISE. BOTH THE ARMY ELEMENTS AND MONITOR 91-1, WHICH HAD SUPPORTED THE INSERTION, RETURNED THE FIRE WITH UNKNOWN RESULTS.

THE MRF WAS VISITED TUESDAY BY THE AUSTRALIAN AMBASSADOR TO VIETNAM. THE AMBASSADOR AND HIS PARTY OF NINE RECEIVED A BRIEFING ON MRF OPERATIONS.

A FAREWELL PARTY FOR BRIGADIER GENERAL FULTON WAS HELD AT NOON TUESDAY IN THE BENEWAH HARBOR. GENERAL FULTON, ASSISTANT COMMANDER OF THE NINTH INFANTRY DIVISION AND FORMER COMMANDING OFFICER OF THE SECOND BRIGADE, LEAVES TODAY FOR FORT POPE, LOUISIANA, WHERE HE WILL BECOME COMMANDER OF THE U.S. ARMY TRAINING CENTER.
