THERE WAS NO CONTACT REPORTED SATURDAY BY 3/47 AND 3/60
INFANTRY BATTALIONS AS THEY CONDUCTED A SECOND DAY OF SEARCH AND
DESTROY OPERATIONS NORTHWEST OF MY THO.

BOATS OF RIVER DIVISION 92 AND 111 TRANSPORTED THE ARMY
TROOPS INTO DONG TAM EARLY IN THE MORNING. FROM THERE, HELICOPTERS
AIRLIFTED THEM TO THEIR OBJECTIVES, BUT THERE WERE NO HOSTILE
INCIDENTS REPORTED DURING THE NEXT SEVEN HOURS OF OPERATIONS.
SEVERAL AMMUNITION CACHES WERE DISCOVERED, HOWEVER, AND ONE TON
OF RICE WAS CONFISCATED. THE ARMY ELEMENTS WERE AIRLIFTED BACK

TO DONG TAM LATER IN THE AFTERNOON, WITH THE ASSAULT BOATS
RETURNING THEM TO THE MRB.

MY THO. THE CREWMAN, A 20MM GUNNER ON ASPB-112-7, RECEIVED MINOR
SHRAPNEL WOUNDS WHEN A SHELL EXPLODED IN HIS MOUNT.

THE MRB WAS VISITED SATURDAY BY MR HOLT, AN
EX-CONGRESSMAN WHO NOW IS SERVING AS A CORRESPONDENT WITH THE
VALLEY NEWS OF VAN NUYS, CALIFORNIA. HE RECEIVED A BRIEFING
ON MRB OPERATIONS FROM COMMODORE SALZER AND LIEUTENANT COLONEL
LOCKMAN, EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF SECOND BRIGADE.
