DAILY INTERNAL INFOPMATH SUMMARY HQ 22-12

ONLY ONE BRIEF FLURRY OF CONTACT WAS REPORTED SUNDAY BY ELEMENTS OF 3/60 AND 3/47 INFANTRY BATTALION OPERATING UP THE KINH XANG NORTH OF DONT TAM.

THIS OCCURRED EARLY IN THE AFTERNOON WHEN CHARLEY COMPANY OF 3/60 INFANTRY RECEIVED SMALL ARMS AND AUTOMATIC WEAPONS FIRE. THERE WERE THREE ARMY PERSONNEL REPORTED WOUNDED--THE ONLY U.S. CASUALTIES OF THE DAY. THERE WAS ONE VC KIA. ONE OF THE LARGEST CACHES OF ENEMY WEAPONS EVER TO BE CAPTURED BY THE MRF WAS TAKEN TODAY. INCLUDED IN THE CACHE WERE 13 U.S. CARBINES, 6 .45 CALIBER SUBMACHINE GUNS, 8

BRONING AUTOMATIC RIFLES, 19 CHINESE CARBINES, 18 GREASE GUNS, 1 M-16, 1 M-1, 43 B-40 ROCKET ROUNDS, 1 82MM MORTAR ROUND, 12 75MM ROUNDS AND 100 60MM ROUNDS.

THE ARMY TROOPS WERE AIRLIFTED INTO THE OPERATING AREA SUNDAY MORNING AFTER BEING TRANSPORTED INTO DONG TAM ABOARD ATC'S OF RIVER DIVISIONS 92 AND 111.

ASSAULT CRAFT IN THE AO INCLUDE UNITS OF RIVER DIVISION 91 WHICH ARE SUPPORTING ARTILLERY ELEMENTS AND THE CCR'S AND ONE ATC EACH FROM 92 AND 111. THESE BOATS ARE PROVIDING COMMAND AND CONTROL AND OTHER SUPPORT FOR THE TWO BATTALIONS AND FOR THE FIRE SUPPORT BASE.
