ARMY ELEMENTS OPERATING SOUTH OF CAN THO REPORTED MODERATE CONTACT WEDNESDAY WHILE CAPTURING ONE OF THE LARGEST ENEMY ARMS CACHES IN THE MRF'S ONE-YEAR HISTORY. THIS IS THE SECOND LARGE WEAPONS CACHE CAPTURED IN THE PAST WEEK.

ONE INFANTRYMAN WAS KILLED AND 10 WERE WOUNDED AS A RESULT OF SPORADIC SMALL ARMS, AUTOMATIC WEAPONS AND OTHER HEAVY FIRE DURING THE DAY. IN ADDITION, 14 OTHERS WERE WOUNDED WHEN GUNSHIPS SUPPORTING THE GROUND FORCES WHO WERE IN HEAVY, CLOSE CONTACT WITH THE ENEMY HAD SOME OF THEIR ROCKETS IMPACT AMONG OUR TROOPS.

AMONG THE ENEMY ARMS CONFISCATED WERE 460 B-40 ROCKET ROUNDS, 166 B-40 CHARGES, 279 MISCELLANEOUS GRENADES, 112 ANTI-PERSONNEL WEAPONS, 92 RPG-7 CHARGES AND ASSORTED OTHER WEAPONS, MORTAR ROUNDS AND EXPLOSIVES.

BOATS OF RIVER DIVISION 91 AND ELEMENTS OF 3/34 ARTILLERY BATTALION WERE THE FIRST TO ENTER THE OPERATING AREA IN THE CAI RANG DISTRICT OF PHONG DINH PROVINCE. THEY ESTABLISHED A FIRE SUPPORT BASE ONE MILE SOUTH OF CAN THO IN ORDER TO COVER ELEMENTS OF 3/47 INFANTRY BATTALION AS THEY WERE INSERTED AT THEIR OBJECTIVE BEACHES BY BOATS OF RIVER DIVISION 92 BETWEEN 0705 AND 0720.

THE BOATS THEN ASSUMED BLOCKING POSITIONS ON THE CAN THO RIVER TO PREVENT ANY ENEMY ESCAPE ON THE WATER ROUTES, BUT NO SIGNIFICANT SAMPAN ACTIVITY OR OTHER SUSPICIOUS MOVEMENTS WERE REPORTED.

THE APL-26 AND BOATS OF RIV DIV 111 COMPLETED THEIR TRANSIT FROM NEAR THE CROSSOVER FROM THE MEKONG TO THE BASSAC RIVERS TO CAN THO AT 1340 WEDNESDAY.

THE TWO COMPANIES OF 3/60 INFANTRY EMBARKED ON THE APL WERE INSERTED IN THE AO BY BOATS OF RIV DIV 111 AT 2000.

IN ADDITION TO THE OPERATIONS SOUTH OF CAN THO, COMMANDER RIVER ASSAULT DIVISION 112 AND FOUR OF HIS UNITS ARE PATROLLING IN A SUSPECTED VC CROSSING AREA ON THE BASSAC RIVER SOUTHEAST OF THE MRB.

THE MRB WAS VISITED WEDNESDAY BY MR. NEWBOLD NOYES, EDITOR OF THE WASHINGTON, D.C. STAR. HE WAS GIVEN A BRIEFING ON MRB OPERATIONS BY CAPTAIN ALLEN, VISITED RIVER ASSAULT CRAFT ALONGSIDE THE BENEWAH'S PONTOONS, AND RECEIVED AN ORIENTATION RIDE IN AN ASPB.
