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DAILY INTERNAL INFO SUMMARY 02-29

ASPB-112-4, WHICH SANK SOUTHWEST OF CAN THO FOLLOWING A HEAVY FIRE FIGHT TUESDAY MORNING, WAS LOCATED AT 1415 WEDNESDAY AFTER AN EXTENSIVE SEARCH BY BOATS OF RIVER SQUADRON ELEVEN, LIGHT-LIFT CRAFT-FOUR AND EOD AND UDT PERSONNEL.

THE LIGHT LIFT CRAFT WAS UNABLE TO RAISE THE BOAT BEFORE SUNDOWN, HOWEVER, AND IT WAS SCHEDULED TO RESUME SALVAGE OPERATIONS THURSDAY MORNING.

LLC-4 REMAINED IN THE AO WEDNESDAY NIGHT, ALONG WITH NINE BOATS OF RIV DIV 91 AND SEVEN UNITS OF RIV DIV 111. BOATS OF RIV DIV 92 TRANSPORTED BRAVO COMPANY OF 3/47 INFANTRY TO THE VICINITY OF THE SUNKEN BOAT EARLY WEDNESDAY EVENING TO PROVIDE FURTHER SECURITY. THE BOATS RETURNED TO THE MRB AFTER THE TROOPS HAD BEEN LANDED.

ALL BUT TWO OF THE 10 FLOTILLA PERSONNEL INJURED IN THUESDAY MORNING'S ATTACK HAVE BEEN TREATED AND RELEASED. BMC NIEL KOSKI OF MONITOR 111-3 IS BEING TREATED FOR FRAGMENT WOUNDS BUT IS IN GOOD CONDITION.

THE ONLY ONE OF 10 WITH SERIOUS INJURIES IS FM ALBERT READER OF ASPB 112-4 WHO IS IN THE THIRD SURGICAL HOSPITAL AT DONG TAM WITH FRAGMENT WOUNDS IN THE HEAD, ARMS AND ABDOMEN.
