DAILY INTERNAL INFORMATION SUMMARY NO. 93-26

THE MRB RECEIVED SIGNIFICANT HOSTILE FIRE FOR THE FIRST TIME IN ITS YEAR OF OPERATIONS IN THE DELTA EARLY TUESDAY MORNING WHEN AN ESTIMATED TEN ROCKET OR RECOILLESS RIFLE ROUNDS WERE FIRED AT THE SOWICK COUNTY.

THERE WERE NO PERSONNEL CASUALTIES AS ONLY ONE OF THE ROUNDS PENETRATED THE HULL, CAUSING MINOR DAMAGE IN A COMPARTMENT. THE FIRE ORIGINATED FROM THE SOUTH BANK, BUT A LIGHT HELO FIRE TEAM CALLED IN SPOTTED NO UNUSUAL ACTIVITY IN THE AREA.

DONG TAN RECEIVED SPORADIC MORTAR AND RECOILLESS RIFLE THROUGHOUT TUESDAY MORNING AND AGAIN DURING THE AFTERNOON. NINETY ROUNDS WERE RECEIVED DURING PRE-DAWN ATTACKS WITH NINE PERSONNEL SUSTAINING MINOR INJURIES.

AT 1705 FOUR MORE PERSONNEL WERE WOUNDED WHEN 20 ROUNDS FELL ON THE BASE IN THE AFTERNOON.

IN ADDITION TO THE MORTAR FIRE, ARMY SECURITY ELEMENTS ON THE NORTH BANK TOOK SMALL GROUPS OF VC UNDER FIRE AT 0145 AND 0430. THERE WERE NO KNOWN CASUALTIES ON EITHER SIDE AS A RESULT OF THE EXCHANGE OF FIRE.

SALVAGE OPERATIONS ON ASPB-91-1, WHICH SANK SOUTHWEST OF CAN THO LAST SATURDAY, CONTINUED TUESDAY, BUT LIGHT LIFT CRAFT THREE WAS UNABLE TO RECOVER THE SUNKEN BOAT BY SUNDOWN. COMMANDER, RIVER ASSAULT DIVISION 111 AND SIX OF HIS UNITS REMAIN IN THE AREA TO SUPPORT THE OPERATIONS.

THE 4/47 INFANTRY BATTALION COMPLETED ITS MOVE ABOARD COLLETON AND WASHTENAW COUNTY TUESDAY. THE RIVER DIVISIONS ALSO SHIFTED SHIPS, WITH RIV DIV 91 MOVING TO THE COLLETON, 92 TO THE WASHTENAW COUNTY, 111 TO THE BENEWAH AND 112 TO APL-26.
