DAILY INTERNAL INFORMATION SUMMARY NO. 403-17

ALL ELEMENTS OF 3/60 AND 4/47 INFANTRY BATTALIONS RETURNED TO THE MRB SATURDAY AFTER COMPLETING A TWO-DAY OPERATION NORTHEAST OF MY THO IN WHICH 26 VIET CONG WERE KILLED.

MOST OF THE FIGHTING TOOK PLACE BETWEEN 1600 AND 2030 FRIDAY, BUT SPORADIC CONTACT CONTINUED THROUGHOUT THE NIGHT AND SATURDAY MORNING AS THE ENEMY FORCE EXFILTRATED THE AREA. ELEMENTS POLICING UP THE HEAVILY-BUNKERED POSITIONS LATER IN THE DAY FOUND SEVERAL BODIES AND WEAPONS AND SIZABLE AMOUNTS OF AMMUNITION AND MEDICAL SUPPLIES.

FRIENDLY CASUALTIES IN THE TWO-DAY BATTLE WERE SEVEN KILLED AND 20 WOUNDED. SEVEN OTHER ARMY PERSONNEL WERE WOUNDED BY BOOBY TRAPS FRIDAY.

TO THE MRB AFTER THEY WERE AIRLIFTED FROM THE AO TO DONG TAM.
REPORTS FROM I CORPS SATURDAY STATED THAT TWO WERE KILLED AND FOUR ARE STILL MISSING AS A RESULT OF THURSDAY'S MINING OF ATC 112-7 IN THE THACH HAN RIVER. THE SEVENTH CREWMEN WAS SERIOUSLY INJURED IN THE BLAST WHICH SEVERELY DAMAGED THE CRAFT AND FLIPPED IT COMPLETELY UPSIDE DOWN.

MEANWHILE, THE OTHER ASSAULT BOATS CONTINUED THEIR PATROLS BETWEEN CUA VIET AND DONG HA SUPPLY CENTER, REPORTING NO INCIDENTS DURING TRANSITS ON FRIDAY.
