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DAILY INTERNAL INFO SUMMARY

A QUIET DAY WAS REPORTED SUNDAY BY MRF ELEMENTS COMPLETING TWO-DAY OPERATION EAST OF CAI BE.

THE ONLY INCIDENT IN THE AT OCCURRED AT 1100 WHEN ASSAULT EAST OF RIVER DIVISION 92 RECEIVED HEAVY SMALL ARMS FIRE FROM BOTH BANKS OF THE NAM THON RIVER. THE BOATS, WHICH WERE WITHDRAWING FROM THE BEACH AFTER BACKLOADING 8/68 INFANTRY, QUICKLY SUPPRESSED THE FIRE WITH UNKNOWN RESULTS. THERE WERE NO FRIENDLY CASUALTIES.

ALL MRF ELEMENTS CLOSED THE MRS BY 1715.

IN ANOTHER INCIDENT INVOLVING TF 117 UNITS, A GROUP OF BOATS MOVING DOWN THE KINH XANG NORTH OF THE LONG DINH BRIDGE RECEIVED TWO NEAR MISSES FROM ROCKETS AT 1100. THE TWO ROUNDS

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PASSED BETWEEN AN ATC AND MONITOR AND EXPLODED ON THE OPPOSITE BANK. THE BOATS RETURNED FIRE WITH ALL WEAPONS, INCLUDING THE NEWLY INSTALLED FLAMETHROWER ON MONITOR 92-1.

THE UNITS WERE MOVING SOUTH ON THE CANAL AFTER HAVING UNCOVERED UP A LARGE ENEMY WEAPONS CACHE CAPTURED SATURDAY BY ARVN

WODCRE SALZER AND LORR SCOTT MC CAULEY, THE FLORIDA ASST PLANS OFFICER, WERE SCHEDULED TO DEPART SAIGON SUNDAY FOR A CONFERENCE AT THE AMPHIBIOUS BASE IN CORONADO.

THE FOUR-DAY MEETING HAS BEEN ARRANGED TO DISCUSS ARRANGEMENTS BEING MADE TO DOUBLE THE SIZE OF THE MRF WITHIN THE NEXT SIX MONTHS.
