DAILY INTERNAL INFORMATION SUMMARY 05-01

SHIPS OF THE MRB CAME UNDER HEAVY ROCKET FIRE FROM THE SOUTH BANK EARLY TUESDAY MORNING, BUT DESPITE THE HEAVY ATTACK, THERE WERE NO HITS AND NO CASUALTIES.

AN ESTIMATED 25 ROUNDS WERE RECEIVED BETWEEN 0200 AND 0215, AND THE COLLETON, APL, TOM GREEN COUNTY, AND ASKARI ALL REPORTED SEVERAL NEAR MISSES. THE ATTACK WAS LAUNCHED JUST MINUTES AFTER DONG TAN WAS HIT BY THE FIRST OF FIVE MORTAR AND RECOILLESS RIFLE ATTACKS.

THE SHIPS RETURNED FIRE WITH 40MM, 3" / 50'S, AND MACHINE GUNS, AND A LIGHT HELO FIRE TEAM STRAFED THE ENEMY POSITIONS.

AT DONG TAN, SIX PERSONNEL WERE WOUNDED IN THE SERIES OF ATTACKS, WHICH INCLUDED 120 MM MORTAR ROUNDS AND 75 MM
