DAILY INTERNAL INFO SUMMARY 05-05

A BOOBY TRAP CONSISTING OF A CHINESE COMMUNIST GRENADE INJURED THREE ARMY PERSONNEL IN THE ONLY INCIDENT REPORTED SUNDAY BY ALPHA AND BRAVO COMPANIES OF 3/47 INFANTRY OPERATING ON THE SOUTH BANK OF THE SONG MY THO OPPOSITE THOI SON ISLAND. BOATS OF RIVER DIVISIONS 112 INSERTED BRAVO COMPANY AT 1225, REPLACING ECHO COMPANY 3/47 WHICH WAS EXTRACTED FOR RETURN TO THE MRB.

A TOTAL OF FIVE VIETNAMESE WITHOUT IDENTIFICATION CARDS WERE DETAINED AND THREE DUD 105MM ROUNDS WERE DISCOVERED IN THE ONLY SIGNIFICANT RESULTS OF THE TWO COMPANY OPERATION. OTHER MRF ELEMENTS REMAINED IN A STATE OF MAXIMUM READINESS SUNDAY IN RESPONSE TO A WAVE OF HARRASSING ATTACKS THROUGHOUT

THE DELTA SATURDAY NIGHT. ALTHOUGH THERE WAS NO SIGNIFICANT GROUND ACTION, A NUMBER OF CITIES REPORTED RECEIVING HEAVY MORTAR FIRE, INCLUDING MY THO, VINH LONG, CAN THO, TAN AN AND NHA BE. IN THE FIRST ACTUAL RELOCATION OF MRF FORCES, ONE INFANTRY COMPANY AND AN ARTILLERY BATTERY WERE DISPATCHED TO THE CAI BE-CAI LAY AREA TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL SECURITY TO THOSE TWO CITIES. ALPHA COMPANY OF 4-47 INFANTRY WAS AIRLIFTED TO A LOCATION NORTH OF CAI BE AT 1700, WHILE THE ARTILLERY OF ALPHA BATTERY 3-34 DEPARTED THE MRB AT 1700. THEY WERE BEING ESCORTED TO A FIRE SUPPORT BASE NEAR CAI BE BY THE CHIEF STAFF OFFICER AND FOUR BOATS OF RIVER DIVISION 92. A CREW MEMBER OF MONITOR 111-2 IS MISSING AND PRESUMED DROWNED AFTER HE FELL OFF THE TOM GREEN COUNTY PONTOONS AT 1700 SATURDAY. AN INTENSIVE SEARCH OF THE MRB ANCHORAGE AREA WAS LAUNCHED IMMEDIATELY, BUT PRODUCED NEGATIVE RESULTS.
