DAILY INTERNAL INFORMATION SUMMARY 05-24

THE BRIEF EXCHANGE OF FIRE LATE IN THE AFTERNOON INTERRUPTED AN OTHERWISE QUIET DAY FRIDAY AS 3/47 INFANTRY CONDUCTED A SEARCH AND SWEEP OPERATION ON THE SOUTH BANK OF THE SONG MY THO OPOSITE THOI SON ISLAND.

AN ARMY INFANTRYMAN WAS KILLED BY THE HOSTILE FIRE AT 1630 JUST AS THE TROOPS WERE PREPARING TO COMMENCE AN AIRLIFT OUT OF THE AO. THERE WERE THREE ENEMY KILLED IN THE INCIDENT. OTHER RESULTS OF THE SWEEP WERE THREE WOODEN MORTAR PLATES AND 28 BUNKERS DESTROYED.

THE THREE COMPANIES OF 3/47 INFANTRY WERE LANDED ON THE SOUTH BANK AT 0705 BY ASSAULT CRAFT OF RIVER DIVISION 111. AFTER MOVING SOUTH AND EAST FOR 16 HOURS, THE TROOPS WERE AIRLIFTED INTO

DONG TAMBON BETWEEN 1700 AND 1730 AND WERE RETURNED TO THE MRB BY THE 111 BOATS.

ELEMENTS OF 3/60 INFANTRY COMPLETED THEIR MOVE ABOARD COLLETON AND VERNON COUNTY FRIDAY AS 4/47 INFANTRY MOVED INTO DONG TAMBON AND ASSUMED RESPONSIBILITY FOR DEFENSE OF THE ARMY BASE.
