FIVE FIET CONG WERE KILLED TUESDAY BY MRF ELEMENTS OPERATING WEST OF THE MRB IN THE MO CAY AND DON NHON DISTRICTS OF KIEN HOA PROVINCE.

FOUR ENEMY DEAD WERE CLAIMED BY HELICOPTER GUNSHIPS AND THE FIFTH WAS KILLED AT 0335 BY ASSAULT BOATS DURING A FIREFIGHT ON THE MO CAY RIVER.

THERE WERE NO U. S. CASUALTIES DUE TO HOSTILE FIRE DURING THE DAY.

IN THE INCIDENT INVOLVING THE ASSAULT CRAFT, ENEMY FIRE WAS CONFINED TO AUTOMATIC WEAPONS AND SMALL ARMS. THE ATTACK WAS LAUNCHED WITH THE DETONATION OF A CLAYMORE MINE, BUT THE HOSTILE FIRE WAS QUICKLY SUPPRESSED BY THE BOATS WHICH LEVELED THE ENEMY POSITIONS WITH ALL WEAPONS.

BETWEEN 0730 AND 0745 AND SWEEPED TOWARD EACH OTHER FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE DAY, REPORTING NO SIGNIFICANT CONTACT WHILE DETAINING 45 SUSPICIOUS VIETNAMESE FOR FURTHER QUESTIONING.

MOST OF THE BOATS RETURNED TO THE MRB IN THE MORNING, ALTHOUGH SEVERAL UNITS OF RIVER DIVISIONS 91 AND 111 REMAINED AT THE FIRE SUPPORT BASE TO PROVIDE COMMUNICATIONS SUPPORT.

LT. COL. JAMES L. SCOVEL ARRIVED YESTERDAY TO BECOME THE NEW EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF THE SECOND BRIGADE. HE COMES TO THE MRF FROM THE INFANTRY BRANCH OF THE OFFICE OF PERSONNEL OPERATIONS IN WASHINGTON, D.C. LT. COL. CONLIN, USMC, WHO HAS BEEN ACTING XO SINCE. LT. COL. LACKMAN LEFT TO TAKE COMMAND OF 3/47 INFANTRY BATTALION, WILL CONTINUE HIS DUTIES ON THE BRIGADE STAFF AS RIVERINE ADVISER.
