THERE WERE NO CASUALTIES AND NO SIGNIFICANT DAMAGE EARLY FRIDAY MORNING AS THE COLLETON TOOK ONE RECOILLESS RIFLE HIT IN A FIVE-ROUND ATTACK ON THE MRF AT 3343.

THE ROUND CAUSED A THREE-INCH HOLE IN THE BULKHEAD OF THE WEAPONS OFFICER'S STATEROOM, BUT FORTUNATELY IT FAILED TO DETONATE.

THE COLLETON AND BID PATROLS RETURNED THE FIRE, WHICH ORIGINATED FROM THE EAST BANK, WITH UNKNOWN RESULTS.

THE MRF HOSTED A NUMBER OF DISTINGUISHED VISITORS FRIDAY. MAJOR GENERAL YOSE DEVAHASDIN, COMMANDER OF THE ROYAL THAI FORCES IN VIETNAM, WAS BRIEFED ON MRF OPERATIONS BY COMMODORE SALZER AND COLONEL ARCHER.
