SECOND BRIGADE ELEMENTS REPORTED A DRY RUN WEDNESDAY AS THEY SWEEPED THROUGH A FIVE-KILOMETER STRETCH ALONG THE CAN LO RIVER EAST OF THE CITY OF CAO LANH.

THERE WAS NO HOSTILE CONTACT ALL DAY, AND THE ONLY SIGNIFICANT RESULTS OF THE OPERATION WERE THE DESTRUCTION OF 81 BUNKERS AND THE DETAINING OF 94 VIETNAMESE FOR QUESTIONING.

BOATS OF RIVER DIVISION 92 BEACHED 3/60 INFANTRY ABOUT 0745, WHILE ELEMENTS OF 3/47 INFANTRY WERE AIRLIFTED INTO THE AO AFTER BEING TRANSPORTED TO A PICK-UP ZONE BY DIVISION 111 BOATS.

THE TROOPS WERE BACKLOADED BETWEEN 1630 AND 1700 FOR RETURN TO THE MRB.
