DAILY INTERNAL INFORMATION SUMMARY 06-08

A SECOND STRAIGHT DAY WITHOUT CONTACT WAS REPORTED SATURDAY BY SECOND BRIGADE ELEMENTS OPERATING IN THE GIAO DUC DISTRICT OF DIEN TUONG PROVINCE.

RESULTS OF THE TWO-DAY OPERATION, WHICH ENDED IN THE EARLY AFTERNOON, WERE THREE VC KILLED AND SIX PRISONERS OF WAR APPREHENDED.

CUMULATIVE ALLIED CASUALTIES WERE ONE KILLED AND 12 WOUNDED, 10 OF THEM BY BOOBY TRAPS. THE FATALITY AND ONE OF THE WIA WERE VIETNAMESE RIVER SCOUTS WORKING WITH 3/63 INFANTRY.

THE TWO BATTALIONS WERE EXTRACTED BY BOATS OF RIVER DIVISIONS 52 AND 111 BETWEEN 1300 AND 1345. THE ARMY ELEMENTS COMPLETED LOADING ABOARD THE SHIPS AT 1415, AND THE MRB GOT UNDERWAY ALMOST IMMEDIATELY FOR THE THREE AND ONE-HALF HOUR TRANSIT TO DONG TAN.

THE RAPID RELOCATION OF THE MRB WAS DESIGNED TO BOLSTER THE AR 111'S

DEFENSIVE POSTURE AT DONG TAN. SEVERAL COMPANIES OF 4/47 INFANTRY WERE AIRLIFTED FROM THE BASE EARLIER IN THE DAY TO SUPPORT FIRST BRIGADE ELEMENTS WHICH WERE INVOLVED IN HEAVY CONTACT WITH THE 514TH VC BATTALION.
