DAILY INTERNAL INFORMATION SUMMARY 36-39

TROOPS OF 3/60 INFANTRY BATTALION WERE RETURNED TO THE MRB SUNDAY AFTERNOON AFTER BEING PICKED UP NEAR THE LONG DINH BRIDGE BY BOATS OF RIVER DIVISION 92.

THE INFANTRYMEN WERE COMMITTED TO ROUTE 4, 1ST BRIGADE FSPB AND DONG TAM SECURITY SATURDAY AFTERNOON WHEN THE REGULAR SECURITY ELEMENTS WERE RUSHED TO THE SUPPORT OF FIRST BRIGADE ELEMENTS WHO WERE REPORTED TO BE IN HEAVY CONTACT.

CHIEF JOURNALIST HENKEMEYER OF THE CINCPACFLT PUBLIC AFFAIRS OFFICE IS PRESENTLY MAKING A TWO DAY VISIT TO THE MRF TO RECORD COMBAT ACTION INTERVIEWS WITH IF 117 BOAT CREWMEN. THE CHIEF SPENT SUNDAY AFTERNOON TALKING TO PERSONNEL OF RIV DIV 111.
