DAILY INTERNAL INFORMATION SUMMARY 06-13

NEITHER ARMY NOR NAVY ELEMENTS REPORTED ANY SIGNIFICANT HOSTILE CONTACT THURSDAY WHILE CONDUCTING A SWEEP ALONG THE BA KAI RIVER EAST OF "FOUR CORNERS."

THE OPERATION WAS ORIGINALLY PLANNED FOR TWO DAYS, BUT WHEN NO ENEMY FORCES WERE ENCOUNTERED BY LATE IN THE AFTERNOON, THE TWO BATTALIONS WERE BACKLOADED ABOUT 1830 AND RETURNED TO THE MRB.

RIVER ASSAULT DIVISIONS 92 AND 111 HAD BEACHED THE TROOPS BETWEEN 1000 AND 1030, AFTER UNITS OF RIV DIV 91 MADE A TRANSIT UP THE CHO GAO CANAL TO CONDUCT A MEDCAP IN THE VICINITY OF THE FERRY CROSSING. ABOUT 200 PATIENTS WERE TREATED BY LT. ZIEGLER, HM2 CHARLES MCKAY
