DAILY INTERNAL INFO SUMMARY 06-17

ARMY HELICOPTER GUNSHIPS KILLED 33 VIET CONG MONDAY IN SUPPORT OF SECOND BRIGADE FORCES SWEEPING THROUGH AND AREA 10 KILOMETERS SOUTH OF CAN THO.

MOST OF THE ACTION OCCURRED BETWEEN 0800 AND 0900 AFTER BOATS OF RIVER DIVISION 92 HAD BEACHED 3/60 INFANTRY ON THE CAI DAI RIVER. NEITHER 3/60 NOR 3/47 INFANTRY, WHICH WAS LANDED ON THE BA LANG RIVER ABOUT 0615, ENCOUNTERED ANY SIGNIFICANT ENEMY FORCES AS THEY SWEEP TOWARD EACH OTHER FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE DAY. TWO WOUNDED VIET CONG NURSES WERE CAPTURED BY 3/60 INFANTRYMEN ABOUT 1130.

A FEW SNIPER ROUNDS COMPRISED THE ONLY RESISTENCE REPORTED BY THE BOATS DURING THEIR TRANSIT DOWN THE CAI DAI AND BA LANG RIVERS.

FIVE CREWMEN OF MONITOR 91-1 OPERATING WITH TASK GROUP BRAVO IN THE RUNG STA SPECIAL ZONE RECEIVED MONOR WOUNDS AT 1215 SUNDAY WHEN THE ASSAULT BOATS WERE AMBUSED FROM BOTH BANKS OF THE DONG TRANH RIVER.

THE ATTACK OCCURRED IN THE SAME AREA WHERE THE BOATS HAD BEEN HIT EARLIER IN THE MORNING. FOUR NAVYMEN WERE WOUNDED IN THE FIRST ATTACK. BUT NEITHER THEY NOR THE FIVE INJURED IN THE SECOND AMBUSH WERE SERIOUSLY HURT. IN ADDITION TO THE MONITOR, ASPB'S 111-4 AND 92-5 AND ATC 131-5 WERE HIT IN THE SECOND ROCKET AND AUTOMATIC WEAPONS ATTACK. THE BOATS AND A HELICOPTER FIRE TEAM SUPPRESSED THE ENEMY FIRE.

THE USS WASHTENAW COUNTY CLOSED THE MRB AT CAN THO AT 1900 AND BEGAN PREPARATIONS TO RELIEVE THE VERNON COUNTY AS MRF SUPPORT LST.
