JUNE 29 WAS ANOTHER QUIET DAY FOR THE MOBILE RIVERINE FORCE. EARLY SATURDAY MORNING, 3/60 AND 3/47 INFANTRY BATTALIONS, WHICH HAD SPENT THE NIGHT IN THE FIELD IN THE "MOUSE EARS" AREA OF LONG AN PROVINCE, BACKLOADED ABOARD RIVDIV 92 AND 111 BOATS FOR RETURN TO THE MRB. ALL UNITS ARRIVED AT THE ANCHORAGE SHORTLY BEFORE NOON. THE AFTERNOON WAS SPENT REPLENISHING THE FOOD, FUEL, AND AMMUNITION IN THE BOATS IN PREPARATION FOR SUNDAY'S OPERATION.
