DAILY INTERNAL INFO SUMMARY 07-16

WITH SPORADIC CONTACT CONTINUING AT 2000, MRF FORCES HAD REPORTED 13 MORE ENEMY DEAD TUESDAY IN THE SECOND DAY OF OPERATIONS IN THE CANG LONG DISTRICT OF VINH BINH PROVINCE.

THE ADDITIONAL KIA RAISED THE TWO-DAY TOTAL TO 60. SEVERAL OF THE BODIES FOUND TUESDAY WERE THE RESULT OF MODERATE FIGHTING ON MONDAY NIGHT, WHILE THE OTHERS WERE RECORDED DURING TUESDAY'S LIGHT ACTION. AS DARKNESS FELL TUESDAY, ELEMENTS OF 3/60 INFANTRY WERE CONTINUING TO RECEIVE SMALL ARMS AND OCCASIONAL AUTOMATIC WEAPONS FIRE WHILE OPERATING SEVERAL KILOMETERS SOUTH OF THE AREA OF MONDAY'S CONTACT.

GROUND FORCES ACCOUNTED FOR 10 OF THE ENEMY DEAD, WHILE GUNSHIPS AND ARTILLERY CLAIMED THE OTHER THREE.

NAVY ELEMENTS SAW THEIR SHARE OF ACTION AT 1730 WHEN BOATS OF RIVER DIVISION 112 WERE ATTACKED FROM BOTH BANKS OF THE DUA BO RIVER WITH ROCKETS, RECOILLESS RIFLES AND AUTOMATIC WEAPONS. DESPITE THE FACT THAT MONITOR 112-1 RECEIVED TWO DIRECT RPG-2 OR RPG-7 HITS IN THE ASSAULT, THERE WERE NO U.S. CASUALTIES.

ONE OF THE ROCKETS PENETRATED BOTH OF THE MONITOR'S FUEL TANKS, AND THE OTHER STRUCK THE PORT SIDE AMIDSHIPS.

THE BOATS, WHICH HAD JUST BACKLOADED ELEMENTS OF ECHO COMPANY 4/47 INFANTRY, SUPPRESSED THE HOSTILE FIRE AND CONTINUED TO THE FIRE SUPPORT BASE.

MRB ALFA SHIFTED 10 KILOMETERS BACK UP RIVER TUESDAY MORNING, RELOCATING TO AN ANCHORAGE SEVEN KILOMETERS NORTHWEST OF THE AO.

A MEDCAP MISSION WAS CONDUCTED TUESDAY AFTERNOON TO THE VILLAGE OF AP DUC MY. LT. SANTANGELO AND HM1 VIADO OF BENEWAH TREATED ABOUT 120 PATIENTS. MAJ WAGNER OF 2ND BRIGADE HEADQUARTERS COMPANY MADE THE ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE MEDCAP. TRANSPORTATION WAS PROVIDED BY ATC 91-13.
