ALL SECOND BRIGADE ELEMENTS RETURNED TO THE MRB WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON
AFTER A FRUITLESS SWEEP THROUGH THE CANG LONG DISTRICT OF VINH BINH
PROVINCE.

TROOPS OF 3/60 INFANTRY WERE BACKLOADED IN THE AO BY BOATS OF RIVER
DIVISION 91, WHILE 4/47 INFANTRY WAS AIRMOBILED TO A FIRE SUPPORT BASE
FOR PICKUP BY RIV DIV 112 CRAFT. ALL TROOPS WERE BACK ABOARD SHIPS OF
THE MRB AT 1745.

FINAL RESULTS OF THE THREE-DAY OPERATION WERE 62 VIET CONG KILLED AND
TWO CAPTURED. ARMY LOSSES WERE SEVEN KILLED AND 25 WOUNDED, INCLUDING
SIX KNHA AND 18 WNHA AS A RESULT OF FRIENDLY HELICOPTER FIRE.
