ALL ELEMENTS OF THE MRF WERE ON A MAXIMUM ALERT STATUS WEDNESDAY IN THE FACE OF A WIDE OUTBREAK OF ENEMY ATTACKS WHICH IS INTERPRETED AS THE BEGINNING OF THE LONG PREDICTED THIRD OFFENSIVE.

MORE THAN 52 COORDINATED ATTACKS WERE LAUNCHED EARLY WEDNESDAY MORNING AGAINST IV CORPS CITIES, TOWNS, AIRFIELDS AND MILITARY INSTALLATIONS. DONG TAM RECEIVED A TOTAL OF 44 MORTAR ROUNDS IN TWO PRE-DAWN INCIDENTS AND FIVE MORE AT 1122 IN AN UNUSUAL DAYLIGHT ATTACK. THERE WERE NO CASUALTIES AND NO SIGNIFICANT DAMAGE AS A RESULT OF THE THREE MORTARINGS.
