DAILY INTERNAL SUMMARY 03-08

TASK GROUP BRAVO ELEMENTS WERE REPORTED IN LIGHT CONTACT WITH AN
ESTIMATED VC PLATOON THURSDAY AFTERNOON DURING OPERATIONS IN
EASTERN LONG AN PROVINCE, 25 KILOMETERS SOUTH OF SAIGON.

THE CONTACT WAS ACHIEVED BY CHARLEY COMPANY 4/39 INFANTRY
AND ELEMENTS OF 3/39 INFANTRY WERE AIRLIFTED INTO THE AREA IN THE
AFTERNOON TO PROVIDE ASSISTANCE. THERE WAS NO REPORT OF CASUALTIES ON
EITHER SIDE AS OF 1600.

ASSAULT BOATS OF RIVER SQUADRON 16 AND THE INFANTRYMEN THEY WERE
SUPPORTING RECEIVED FIVE MORTAR ROUNDS DURING TWO ATTACKS LATE
WEDNESDAY NIGHT AND EARLY THURSDAY MORNING. THERE WERE NO NAVY CAS-

ALITIES, BUT TWO ARMY PERSONNEL RECEIVED MINOR WOUNDS.

TASK GROUP ALPHA REMAINED IN A READY REACTION POSTURE THURSDAY,
PREPARED TO RESPOND TO ANY MAJOR ENEMY ATTACKS IN WHAT IS NOW
REGARDED AS THE THIRD VC OFFENSIVE.

THE BOAT CAPTAIN OF ATC 111-10 IS MISSING AND PRESUMED DROWNED
AFTER HE FELL OFF AN ASSAULT BOAT IN THE DONG TAK BASIN JUST BEFORE
MIDNIGHT WEDNESDAY. A THOROUGH SEARCH REVEALED NO TRACES OF THE
MISSING MAN.
