DAILY INTERNAL INFO SUMMARY 09-03

NO CONTACT WAS REPORTED BY MRF ELEMENTS SUNDAY AS THE ASSAULT BOATS OF BOTH TASK GROUPS SUPPORTED VIETNAMESE UNITS IN SEARCH AND SWEEP OPERATIONS.

THE BOATS OF CTG 117.2 SUPPORTED A RED CAP AND PSY OPS PROGRAM WHILE OPERATING WITH A BATTALION OF THE ARVN 46TH REGIMENT NINE KILOMETERS SOUTHEAST OF CAN GIOUC. ONE HUNDRED TWENTY VIETNAMESE WERE TREATED BY U. S. DOCTORS AND CORPSMEN, AND 400 LITERS OF COOKING OIL, 130 BOXES OF SOAP AND 22 SACKS OF FLOUR WERE DISTRIBUTED TO RESIDENTS IN THE AREA.

MEANWHILE, BOATS OF RIV DIV 111 BEACHED THREE COMPANIES OF VIETNAMESE REGIONAL FORCE TROOPS FROM BEN TRE WITHOUT INCIDENT

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JUST EAST OF THE CROSSROADS IN KIEN HOA PROVINCE. THEY WERE TRUCKED FROM BEN TRE TO THE FERRY LANDING NEAR MY THO TO BOARD THE BOATS AND LATER SWEEP FROM THEIR BEACHING AREA BACK TOWARD BEN TRE.

OTHER BOATS OF RIV DIV 92 WERE OPERATING WITH A REGIONAL FORCE COMPANY FROM BEN TRE WHILE FERRYING ARTILLERY PIECES FROM THE TOWN OF MO CAY TO DONG TAM. A REDCAP/DENTCAP TEAM WENT ON THE OPERATION TO MO CAY AND TREATED 33 PATIENTS.
