BOTH TASK GROUPS REPORTED ANOTHER QUIET DAY FRIDAY WHILE  
CONTINUING TO SUPPORT THE NINTH DIVISION'S SECOND AND THIRD  
BRIGADES.

SECOND BRIGADE INFANTRY REPORTED SIX WIA AS A RESULT OF  
BOOBY TRAPS BEFORE WRAPPING UP OPERATIONS IN CENTRAL DINH TUONG  
PROVINCE AND IN THE NORTHWESTERN SECTION OF KIEN HOA PROVINCE.

RIVER DIVISION 132 ENCOUNTERED NO RESISTANCE WHILE CONTINUING  
ITS SUPPORT OF 3/39 INFANTRY NEAR CAN GIOUC IN LONG AN PROVINCE.

FIVE MEMBERS OF UDT 11'S HOTEL DETACHMENT RETURNED TO MRB BRAVO  
FRIDAY AFTER COMPLETING 13 DAYS OF OPERATIONS WITH THE 51ST INFANTRY
