ARMY TROOPS OF 4/47 INFANTRY BATTALION WERE RETURNED FROM THE FIELD FRIDAY MORNING BY BOATS OF RIVDIV 111, ARRIVING AT THE MRB ALFA ABOUT 1100.

DURING THE AFTERNOON RIVDIV 92 BOATS LIFTED ALFA AND BRAVO COMPANIES OF 3/47 INFANTRY BATTALION FROM MRB ALFA TO FIRE SUPPORT BASE DAVID WHERE THE TROOPS ARE EXPECTED TO BE DEPLOYED FOR AN EXTENDED PERIOD.

AN AWARDS CEREMONY WAS HELD ON THE USS BENEWAH PONTOON AT 1600 FRIDAY IN WHICH CAPTAIN THOMAS F. BOOKER, CHIEF STAFF OFFICER OF RIVFLOT ONE AND COMMANDING OFFICER OF TASK GROUP ALFA, WAS PRESENTED THE JOINT SERVICE COMMENDATION MEDAL; LT JOHN COLLINS
