DAILY INTERNAL INFO SUMMARY 10-10

THIRTY-EIGHT ASSAULT BOATS OF TASK GROUP BRAVO SUPPORTED A MASSIVE ARVN OPERATION IN THE MOUSE EARS AREA OF LONG AN PROVINCE THURSDAY.

THE BOATS OF RIVER SQUADRON 13 AND 15 WERE WORKING IN CONJUNCTION WITH VIETNAMESE RAG UNITS WHICH ALSO WERE SUPPORTING ARVN UNITS IN THE AREA. THE OPERATION STARTED AT 2200 WEDNESDAY WHEN THE U. S. BOATS LOADED A 7TH ARVN RECON COMPANY AT THE MY THO PBR BASE. THE BOATS CONDUCTED A NIGHT TRANSIT UP THE CHO CAO CANAL TO A FERRY LANDING ON THE SONG VAM CO, 14 KILOMETERS NORTH OF GO CONG, WHERE THEY LOADED THE 2/11 AND 3/12 ARVN BATTALIONS AT ABOUT 0300. CONTINUING WEST ON THE SONG VAM CO AND VAM CO TAY, THE BOATS BEACHED THE ARVN UNITS AT ABOUT 0715.

MEANWHILE, THE VIETNAMESE NAVY BOATS LANDED OTHER ARVN TROOPS ALONG THE CHO GAO CANAL, SOUTH OF THE BEACHING POINTS OF THE U. S. BOATS. THE TASK GROUP BRAVO UNITS WERE SCHEDULED TO EXTRACT THE ARVN TROOPS AFTER THEY COMPLETED THEIR SWEEP THURSDAY AFTERNOON.

A DETACHMENT OF RIV DIV 132 BOATS IN THE CAN GIOUC-NHA BE AREA REPORTED NO SIGNIFICANT RESULTS TUESDAY AND WEDNESDAY WHILE COMPLETING OPERATIONS WITH U. S. TROOPS OF 3/39 INFANTRY. THE 132 BOATS WERE RELIEVED THURSDAY AFTERNOON BY A GROUP OF 151 CRAFT AND WILL RETURN TO MRB BRAVO WITH THE RAS 13-RAS 15 BOATS WHICH SUPPORTED THURSDAY'S ARVN OPERATION.

TWO NAVY PERSONNEL AND AN INFANTRYMAN WERE WOUNDED DURING A BRIEF ROCKET ATTACK ON RIVER DIVISION 111 BOATS MOVING UP THE BEN TRE RIVER THURSDAY AFTERNOON. THE ATTACK WAS LAUNCHED AT 1335 JUST AFTER THE BOATS HAD BACKLOADED TWO COMPANIES OF 4/47 INFANTRY.

AIC 111-8 SUSTAINED TWO ROCKETS HITS IN THE ATTACK. THE BOATS RETURNED AND SUPPRESSED THE FIRE. THERE WERE NO FURTHER INCIDENTS DURING THEIR MOVEMENT BACK TO MRB ALFA.

LIGHT LIFT CRAFT-4 AND UDT PERSONNEL WERE SCHEDULED TO RETURN TO MRB BRAVO AND ALFA, RESPECTIVELY, AFTER THE SEARCH WAS CALLED OFF FOR THE NAVSUPPACT HELO WHICH CRASHED IN THE HAM LUONG RIVER WEST OF BEN TRE WEDNESDAY MORNING.
