DAILY INTERNAL INFO SUMMARY 10-18

THREE VC BODIES WERE FOUND BY ALFA COMPANY, 3/47 INFANTRY FRIDAY WHILE SWEEPING THROUGH AN AREA FOUR KILOMETERS SOUTHEAST OF BEN TRE. THERE LIGHT CONTACT HAD BEEN REPORTED THE PREVIOUS NIGHT.

THE BODIES WERE FOUND IN FRESHLY-DUG GRAVES AND WERE CREDITED TO ORTAR FIRE WHICH 3/47 ELEMENTS HAD CALLED ON THE ENEMY POSITIONS.

IN OTHER TASK GROUP ALFA ACTION FRIDAY, THE 3RD VIETNAMESE MARINES REPORTED NO CONTACT IN A FIVE-HOUR SWEEP THREE KILOMETERS WEST OF THE CROSSROADS. THE MARINES WERE SUPPORTED BY BOATS OF RIVER DISISION 2.

TASK GROUP BRAVO, WHICH RELOCATED TO VINH LONG THURSDAY, MOVED FURTHER WEST ON THE SONG TIEN GIANG FRIDAY TO THE VICINITY OF THE VAM NAO CROSSOVER. BOATS OF RIV DIV 152 WERE BUSY FRIDAY SUPPORTING

VINH LONG REGIONAL FORCE TROOPS ON THE SONG MANG THIT. THE ASSAULT RRAFT LEFT THE MRB AT 0115 AND NEITHER THEY NOR THE TROOPS HAD REPORTED ANY SIGNIFICANT CONTACT AS OF 1800.

TWO VC WERE KILLED AND ONE CHIEU HOI RALLIED WEDNESDAY DURING RIV DIV 151 OPERATIONS WITH 3/39 INFANTRY IN THE CAN GIOUC-NHA BE AREA.

THE MRF WAS VISITED FRIDAY BY BRIGADIER C.M.I. PEARSON, COMMANDER DESIGNATE OF THE 1ST AUSTRALIAN TASK FORCE.
