NINE VC KIAS WERE REPORTED IN OPERATIONS SE OF BEN TRE
ON TUESDAY. THE US AIR FORCE ACCOUNTED FOR 8 OF THE KILLS
AND THE 3/34 INFANTRY BATTALION WAS CREDITED WITH THE OTHER.
