DAILY INTERNAL INFORMATION SUMMARY 11-15

IN ACTION FRIDAY, 7/47 INFANTRY BATTALION REPORTED ONE VC KIA, TWO SUSPECTS DETAINED, AND TWO CLAYMORE MINES CAPTURED IN OPERATIONS EAST OF TEN TRE IN KIEN HOA PROVINCE. AIR FORCE UNITS ALSO DESTROYED 16 FENEMY STRUCTURES IN THE SAME VICINITY.

BRIGADIER GENERAL J. B. KIDD, USAF, CINCPAC J-30, VISITED MRB ALFA FRIDAY MORNING AND RECEIVED AN ORIENTATION BRIEFING ON MRF OPERATIONS.

LATER IN THE DAY, ERNIE BANKS, FIRST BASEMAN FOR THE CHICAGO CUBS, AND PETE RICKERT, A PITCHER FOR THE BALTIMORE ORIOLES, VISITED THE FORCE. THEY ARE MAKING A USO TOUR TO VARIOUS COMMANDS THROUGHOUT VIETNAM.

MR. RICHARD HUNT, A WRITER FOR THE CHICAGO TRIBUNE, JOINED THE MRF FRIDAY TO GATHER MATERIAL FOR STORIES HE IS WRITING ON COMBAT OPERATIONS IN VIETNAM. HE EXPECTS TO REMAIN WITH THE FORCE FOR SEVERAL DAYS.
