DAILY INTERNAL INFORMATION SUMMARY 11-21

THE VIET CONG CONTINUED TO SUFFER FROM OPERATION FLAMING SWORD ON THURSDAY AS 12 MORE VC KIA'S WERE REPORTED AND 58 ENEMY STRUCTURES DESTROYED.

THE 3/47 INFANTRY BATTALION WAS CREDITED WITH 7 OF THE VC KIA'S AND
INFER ARTILLERY SCORED AN ADDITIONAL TWO IN ACTION LATE WEDNESDAY NIGHT.

THE 3/60 INFANTRY BATTALION KILLED 3 VC, CAPTURED ONE POUND OF DOCUMENTS, THREE POUNDS OF MEDICAL SUPPLIES AND DESTROYED 37 BUNKERS.

ARVN FORCES CAPTURED 3 POW'S WHILE THE US AIR FORCE AND THE 3/34 INFANTRY BATTALION RECORDED 10 AND 12 STRUCTURES DESTROYED EACH.

ON THE 19TH AND 20TH OF THIS MONTH, TASK GROUP BRAVO CONTINUED BLOCKING

AND INTERDICTION OPS IN CENTRAL KIEN GIANG PROVINCE. BOATS OF RIVER ASSAULT SQUADRON 15 RECEIVED B-40 AND AUTOMATIC WEAPONS FIRE FROM THE SOUTH BANK OF THE SONG CAI LON ON THE 20TH. ONE ASFV WAS STRUCK IN THE
