DAILY INTERNAL INFORMATION SUMMARY 11-23

OPERATION MANGROVE SERPENT II BEGAN IN MO CAY DISTRICT OF KIEN HOA PROVINCE SATURDAY, WITH BOATS FROM RIV DIV 112 AND 91 SUPPLYING TRANSPORTATION AND GUNFIRE SUPPORT TO THE VIETNAMESE MARINES AND THE 3/60 INFANTRY BATTALION. LANDINGS WERE MADE ALONG THE SONG HAM LUONG AND THE RACH MO CAY. THE 3/60 AIRMOBILED FURTHER INLAND.

GUNSHIPS, THE AIR CAVALRY, AND ARVN FORCES EACH REPORTED ONE VC KIA DURING THEIR DAY'S OPERATIONS, WHILE AIR FORCE PLANES DESTROYED 8 ENEMY STRUCTURES.

M-131-2 AND T-131-11 ASSISTED 2 PBR'S LATE THURSDAY EVENING IN THE SALVAGE OF ONE DAMAGED PBR AT AN AMBUSH SITE ALONG THE KINH RACH SOI DI VAM. THE BOATS FIRED 105MM AND 20MM ROUNDS INTO THE AMBUSH AREA, BUT NO RETURN FIRE WAS REPORTED.
