SIXTEEN MORE VC WERE KILLED BY THE MRF MONDAY AS ACTION CONTINUED IN KIEN HOA PROVINCE. AIR ACTION ACCOUNTED FOR 8 OF THE KIA'S AND THE 3/34 ARTILLERY BATTALION RECORDED 5 KIA'S. THE AIR FORCE ALSO DESTROYED 27 STRUCTURES.

ELEMENTS OF THE 3/47 INF BN KILLED 2 VIET CONG, CAPTURED ONE CHINESE COMMUNIST CARBINE AND TWO POUNDS OF DOCUMENTS, AND DESTROYED SEVERAL BOOBY TRAPS.

THE 3/60 INF BN KILLED ONE VC, BUT ALSO SUSTAINED ONE FRIENDLY FATALITY AND EIGHT WIA. MOST OF THE CASUALTIES OCCURRED WHEN AN ENEMY BOOBY TRAP EXPLODED.
