DAILY INTERNAL INFORMATION SUMMARY 11-27

OPERATION TIGER CLAW BEGAN WEDNESDAY MORNING WITH TWO COMPANIES OF 3/60 INF BN AND TWO COMPANIES OF 3/47 INF BN CONDUCTING CLOVERLEAF OPS IN THE TRUC GIANG DISTRICT OF KIEN HOA PROVINCE. RAS 11 BOATS PROVIDED THE LIFT FOR BOTH BATTALIONS TO THE OPERATIONS AREA.

SEVEN VC WERE REPORTED KILLED BY THE 3/47 AND ONE RFG-2 LAUNCHER AND TWO ENEMY PACKS WERE CAPTURED. THE 3/60 KILLED FOUR VIET CONG AND CAPTURED TWO CHINESE COMMUNIST GRENADES, ONE CARBINE AND THREE POUNDS OF DOCUMENTS. ONE US SOLDIER WAS ALSO KILLED DURING TODAY'S ACTION. THIRTY-FIVE ENEMY STRUCTURES AND ONE SAMPAN WERE DESTROYED IN WEDNESDAY'S AIR ACTIVITY.

GROUP BRAVO UNITS SEARCHED 257 SAMFANS, CHECKED 352 PEOPLE AND

DETAINED 14 SUSPECTS WEDNESDAY AS OPERATIONS CONTINUED IN THE VICINITY OF THE DUNG ISLAND COMPLEX. ARVN UNITS REPORTED LIGHT GROUND CONTACT AND CAPTURED TWO POW'S, ONE RIFLE, TEN KILOS OF TNT, 50 GRENADES, AND 1000 ROUNDS OF SMALL ARMS AMMUNITION. TWO POW CAMPS, EACH HAVING A 500 PERSON CAPACITY, WERE ALSO DESTROYED.

RARE OPS WERE CONDUCTED ON THE KINH PHU HUU/KINH SANG AND KHEM BANG CO BUT THERE WAS NO CONTACT.
